The outpatient surgery program utilizes medical volunteers to provide free out-patient surgeries to local residents in need. Seven Hospitals participate in the network including Hoag Memorial, Kaiser Permanente, Saddleback Memorial Hospital San Clemente, Saddleback Memorial Hospital Laguna Hills, Mission Hospital, St. Joseph Hospital of Orange County, and Saint Jude Medical Center. More than 400 physicians, nurses and other hospital staff volunteer to provide surgeries for low income patients. Undergraduate students have the opportunity to volunteer at Access OC.
